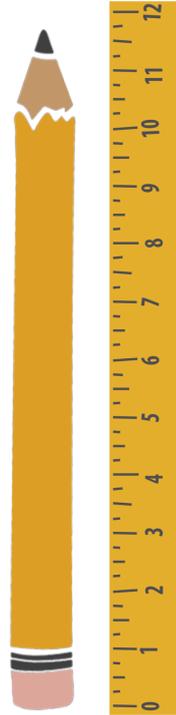

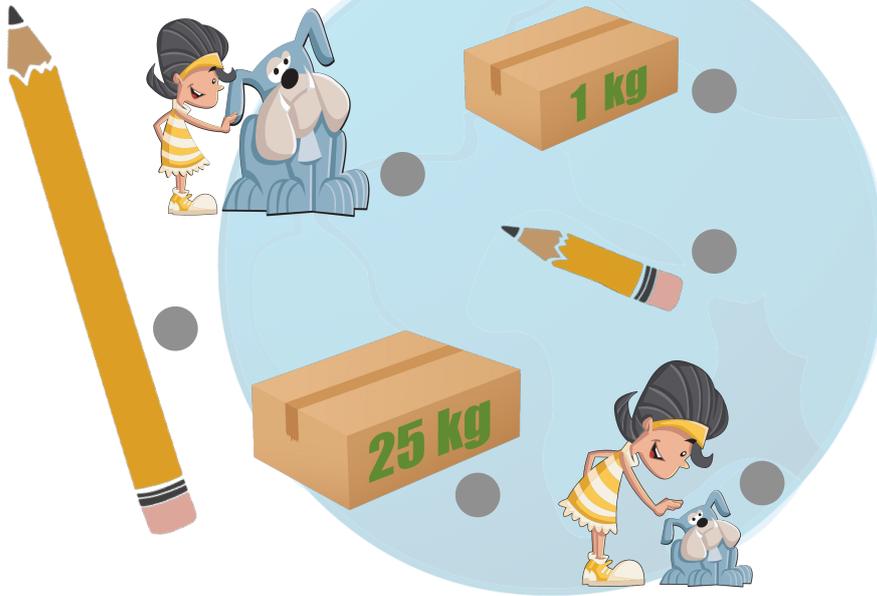

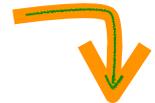

 - b. Roll again: Roll the dice again and move forward.
 - c. Lose a turn: Don't roll the dice on your next turn.
